Business As Usual In Durham For Leading Recycler

Leading tyre and motor trade waste product recycler Credential Environmental stressed this week that it was “business as usual” at its Durham site on the Langley Moor Industrial Estate.

For some years, Newton Aycliffe based Credential has worked at the site alongside tyre re-moulder C Tyres and carpet underlay manufacturer Interfloor, delivering thousands of used car tyres annually to both firms.

Now, with C Tyres in administration, Credential director Steve Patterson stresses that it’s business as usual for his firm on the site, where 90% of tyres delivered went and still do go into the carpet underlay business.

“Only 10% of our deliveries were to C Tyres and the remainder to Interfloor, so it really is business as usual,” said Mr Patterson.
